- Pale Papaya 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" & 3 1/8" x 4 1/8"
- Basic White 4" x 5 1/4"
- Today is the Day cards - 4" x 6" cut to 5 1/4" & 3" x 4"

Daffodil Delight Card Cutting & Scoring:

- Daffodil Delight 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"
- Today is the Day cards - 4" x 6" cut to 5 1/4" & 2@ 3" x 4"

- Cut Memories & More 4" x 6" printed cards to 4" x 5 1/4". Adhere to card bases.
- Add 3" x 4" Memories & More printed cards to card front.
- Color ribbons with Stampin' Blend Markers (Dark Mint Macaron & Dark Daffodil Delight). Tie in bows and add to card fronts with Mini Glue Dots.
- Embellish with Rhinestone Basic Jewels.
- Add layers and DSP strips to insides as shown below.
